### PARADE INFORMATION

- Parade Entry Forms can be emailed to Alie.Walkingbadger@gric.nsn.us or Faxed to (520) 562-0098 or mailed to Tribal Recreation Program c/o MCT Parade P.O. Box 2158, Sacaton, AZ 85147. Please be sure to include copies of AZ Drivers License and Vehicle Insurance Policy of the entry driver. (If needed)
- Registration desk will be located off of BlueBird Rd at Gu u ki Rd; each participant must check in with the registration desk
  to pick up entry number. Parade Coordinator or a volunteer will contact the point of contact to inform the entry of their
  line-up info.
- Ribbons of participation will be given to all entries. Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third place winners in each category of entry.
- 4. Lineup will begin at 7:00 am and end at 8:30 am, if you arrive after this time you will be put at the end of the parade and will not be judged. Line up will begin on Skill Center Rd. (Please see map)
- Parade will begin east of the Governance Center on North Skill Center Rd (rd between Governance Center and Caring
  House) than go East on BlueBird and will end between Cholla Rd and Casa Grande Rd. Breakup will be between Cholla and
  Casa Grande Rd on BlueBird. Approximately 1.5 miles. (See Map)
- 6. Each entry should display their assigned entry number on their vehicle, etc where it is visible for the judges and announcers and should display a sign or banner indicating group.
- Please keep a distance of two car lengths between you and the entry in front of you. Parade committee volunteers will be
  located along the parade route stopping the parade for a few minutes for performers to perform; please watch for
  volunteers and obey their request.
- Announcers will be located east of the Care Center on Ocotillo Rd and also on Cholla Rd; the Judges will be located east of the Care Center on Ocotillo Rd.
- For everyone's safety, parade participants are ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED from throwing candy, coupons, photos, promotional items, fruit, etc from vehicles or floats during the parade, although you may walk along the parade route and hand out items.
- 10. Jumping on and off vehicles, floats, etc is strictly prohibited.
- 11. All children must be accompanied by an adult on the vehicle, floats, etc.
- 12. At the end of the parade, parade participants can be picked up on Bluebird St and Casa Grande Hwy. (See Map)


